Lincoln County Business Owners

It's time to obtain your 2015-2016 Lincoln County Business License.

All business engaging in enterprise within Lincoln County must have a Lincoln County Business License.

THIS INCLUDES:

- **All business located within the unincorporated areas of Lincoln County and those located elsewhere engaging in enterprise within the county.**
- **All business located within incorporated areas of Lincoln County that engage in enterprise elsewhere in the county.**

Exceptions: The provisions contained in this chapter do not apply to:

1. Any business which is wholly located within the limits of any incorporated city or incorporated town within the county.
2. Any private individual(s) who has no more than five (5) garage sales per year.
3. Any nonprofit service organization or Lincoln County School District sponsored event or operation.
4. Anyone providing childcare in private homes to six or fewer children.
5. Anyone telecommuting from home by employees of businesses located elsewhere.
6. Any informal, casual, or seasonal work performed by minors acting as individuals, including, without limitation, babysitting and lawn mowing.
7. Any non retail agricultural business, operating from a ranch or farm, including, without limitation, the husbandry operation of domesticated crops or livestock.
8. Any business that is specifically regulated under a separate chapter of this title and that chapter clearly exempts the business from the provisions of this chapter.

BUSINESS LICENSE RENEWAL DEADLINE is June 30, 2015!

Renewal applications will be mailed to businesses that are currently licensed.

Applications for new licenses can be obtained at the LC Building Department, LC Planning Department or online at lincolncountynv.org, (building department-forms)

Simply complete the application in full (incomplete applications will be returned), provide check or money order for the applicable fee, and send it to: Lincoln County Planning Dept.; PO Box 329; Pioche, NV 89043. You may also drop applications and fees off to the LC Planning Department.

Applications will be reviewed by the Board of Lincoln County Commissioners and if approved, business licenses will be mailed to the business owner.
