FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION the granting of a permit for the purpose set forth herein, the Permittee hereby agrees, covenants and binds said Permittee, as follows, to wit:

- 1) To complete all work in accordance with the plans and studies required and as approved by the Lincoln County Building and Safety Department and the Lincoln County Road Department, if applicable.
2) If the above stated scheduled start date or completion date is changed for any reason, the Permittee shall notify the Building and Safety Department by telephone at least two (2) working days in advance.
3) All work done in the project area shall require inspection.
4) Any work rejected by inspection shall be remedied or removed and replaced by the Permittee in a manner acceptable to the Building and Safety Department or the Lincoln County Road Department, if applicable.
5) Failure to comply with the permit conditions may result in revocation of the permit and the requirement of posting an appropriate performance bond for future permit applications.
6) This approved Permit must be on the job site at all times during the construction process.
7) Permittee MUST notify Lincoln County Building and Safety Department, or the Lincoln County Road Department, if applicable, 48 hours prior to the commencement of work. Failure to do so could result in withdrawal of approval.
8) Work must be completed within working days from the issuance date of the Permit unless otherwise approved in writing by the Building and Safety Department.
9) Permittee or his contractor is solely responsible for the erection and maintenance of all barricades, lights, and traffic control devices in accordance with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).
