The Lincoln County Sheriff's Office is currently seeking a dedicated individual to join our team as a patrol deputy. The patrol deputy would be responsible to work shifts throughout Lincoln County, however, we want this patrol deputy to reside within the city limits of Caliente, Nevada.

As a patrol deputy, you will play a crucial role in maintaining public safety and enforcing the law within Lincoln County. You will be responsible for responding to emergency calls, conducting investigations, apprehending criminals, and preserving peace and order. Your commitment to upholding justice and protecting the rights of our citizens will be paramount in this role.

Requirements for position include:

1. Must be a U.S. citizen. 2. Must be at least 21 years old. 3. Possess a valid driver's license. 4. Have a high school diploma or equivalent. 5. Be physically fit and able to pass a fitness test. 6. Must pass a background investigation, including criminal and credit checks. 7. Have the ability to make quick and sound decisions under pressure.

Prior patrol experience is preferred but not required. The Lincoln County Sheriff's Office is committed to providing comprehensive training to all new hires to ensure your success in the field. We offer competitive benefits, and opportunities for career advancement within our department.

Pay increase incentives -- \$1.00 hourly rate increases for each additional POST certificates. (i.e. intermediate, advanced, and supervisor certificates)
