FAMILY PLANNING

- Contraceptive (birth control) methods for women and men
- Pregnancy testing and counseling
- Fertility counseling to help achieve pregnancy
- Sexually transmitted disease (STDs/AIDS) services: testing, treatment, and education
- Treatment of confidential patients, including minors with or without parental consent

IMMUNIZATIONS

- Routine childhood immunizations
- Back to school requirements: kindergarten, 7th grade, and 12th grade
- Catch up series
- Adult
- Flu vaccine

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

- WIC hemoglobin and lead testing
- Tuberculosis screening, education, treatment, and contact investigation
- School health promotion and education
- Referrals to community resources

FEES

- Clinic fees are based on a sliding scale, so that each patient, regardless of income, can afford services. Proof of monthly income is required (ex: tax return or paycheck stub).
- Medicaid, uninsured patients, and some private insurances are accepted.

CONFIDENTIALITY

Community health nursing is guided by strict confidentiality laws. Nothing may be disclosed to any other person unless the patient authorizes such disclosure in writing.
